<b>Remaining Criteria</b>	A player/pair are capable of winning a medal at the next BWF World Championship or Paralympic Games	A player/pair are capable progressing to Podium level within the next 4 years	A player/pair are capable progressing to Developing or Podium level within the next 4 years
<b>Indicators to Maintain Categorisation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Training minimum 12+ hours p/week</li> <li>- Has a BA registered personal coach</li> <li>- Attends BA HP Para Camps</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Training minimum 10+ hours p/week</li> <li>- Has a BA registered personal coach</li> <li>- Attends BA HP Para Camps</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Training minimum 8+ hours p/week</li> <li>- Has a BA Registered personal coach</li> <li>- Attends BA HP Para Camps</li> </ul>

\* To be eligible for Paralympic selection players must have been selected to the Para Falcons program

\* To be eligible for entry into overseas events players must have entered the Australian National Championships or the State/Territory Championships (or have received an exemption if these events clash with BWF Paralympic qualifying events)

\* The above criteria does not relate to BA processing of international event entries for athletes
